The goal of the St. Edmund's Academy Adopt-A-Scholar program is to provide scholarship assistance to a qualified student applying for or currently enrolled in the Upper School (grades 5-8) and to provide another program for donors motivated to give directly to the tuition account of a qualified student rather directly to the School.

4. **Need based** assessment provided by SSS (School and Student Services for Financial Aid)
